Separate sealed bids for the construction of the Dutoy Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Magnesium Hydroxide Feed System will be received by the Powhatan County until 2:00 PM, local prevailing time on March 21, 2017, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of providing and installing a new Bulk Chemical Storage Tank and all associated equipment at the Dutoy Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. The Project includes, but is not limited to:

1. Provide and install a new Bulk Chemical Storage Tank with Heat Tracing and Insulation.
2. Provide and install a new Mechanical Mixer.
3. Provide and install two new Peristaltic Chemical Metering Pumps.
4. Provide and install a Fiberglass Pump Enclosure.
5. Provide electrical service to all equipment and control panels.
6. Provide and install a Cast-in-Place Concrete Containment Area.
7. Provide and install all pipe and valves for a complete operating system.
8. Provide and install all instrumentation and controls.
9. Provide and install all appurtenances and work as indicated on the contract documents.
